Student Info:

- **Concert attire: Blue top, school-appropriate shorts or khaki pants, and comfortable shoes.**
 - Any shade of blue; any type of shirt. =)
 - Optional: sunglasses or visor
- Band students should report to the LMMS Theater with their instrument, band book, and binder for warm-up by 5:30 PM
 - Please keep all instrument cases in your vehicle
 - Tuba and baritone students should use their “home” instruments (and keep their cases in your vehicle)

Parent info:

- **Concert begins at 6pm!** The 8th grade portion begins at 7pm – feel free to stay and listen!
- Please bring lawn chairs, camping chairs, tail-gating chairs, blankets, or beach towels for your seating.
 - Seating area – the band is arranged in the back portion of the bus area (directly in front of the LMMS fields).
 - You are also welcome to “park” your chairs in the grass behind the media center, under the covered area of the bus lanes, or in the asphalt in front of the LMMS fields.
 - PTSA Gold Member Seating will be sectioned-off for your use
